

Mobile App Security and Privacy

- Smartphones, tablets, and their mobile apps can enable law enforcement and first responders to benefit from these new technologies and perform their jobs more effectively and more efficiently.
- The security and privacy implications of these technologies should be well understood before being deployed.
- Mobile app security, privacy, and use policies should be developed and periodically reviewed.

- Smartphones present new opportunities and new challenges.
- Privacy statutes different from state to state.
- Information sharing regulations differ across federal, state, local, and tribal jurisdictions.
- Technology developers and policy experts need to collaborate to ensure that the end user can be confident that they are using the right technology under the right circumstances.

- Data collected with these mobile devices must be properly protected.
- Data must be properly transmitted and stored after it has been collected.
- Only authorized users should be able to access this data.
- 3rd party in-app instrumentation must also meet the same security and privacy requirements.
