# Goals of the National 911 Program

- Facilitate coordination among public and private stakeholders at local, State and Federal/national levels
- Serve as an information clearinghouse to develop, collect, and disseminate information concerning practices, procedures, and technology used in the implementation of 911 services
- Administer a grant program for the benefit of PSAPs

- IP- and standards-based, high-speed interoperable network for public safety
